

Cecil Township Municipal Authority  
Special Meeting – Lawrence Sewage  
January 15, 2013

The Cecil Township Municipal Authority held a special meeting on Tuesday, January 15, 2013 at the Hills-Henderson Elementary School in Lawrence, PA. Chairman Donald Gennuso called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with Stephanie Lucchino, Blane Volovich, Richard Barnes and Timothy Markovich present. Also present was Jeff Hollowood, Gaitens, Tucceri and Nicholas; Michael Sherrieb, KLH Engineers Inc., Walter O'Shinski P.E. and Dennis Bell, Administrator. Also attending the meeting were Supervisors Tom Casciola, Elizabeth Cowden, Michael Debbis, Frank Ludwin and Andy Shrader.

Michael Malak, Senate Engineers presented information regarding an update of the Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan for the Village of Lawrence, PA. He explained an Act 537 Plan and the various steps needed for updating the Plan. He discussed previous planning completed in 1992 and 2005 and the current plan under consideration. He stated the sewage issues in the area remain. He provided to the audience three options under review for consideration by the Authority board. He explained the pros and cons for each option. He discussed funding options that may be available to the Authority but selecting a funding source occurs after all aspects of the Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan are approved by PA DEP. He provided a summary of costs based on current construction costs. In addition, the summary of costs includes a tap-in fee of \$3,500 and the estimated monthly user rate.

Representatives from Senator Tim Solobay, Congressman Tim Murphy and Representative Jesse White spoke on possible grant funding opportunities for both the Authority and the residents. A question and answer period followed the presentation.

The Board on a motion by Richard Barnes and second by Timothy Markovich the special meeting was adjourned at 8:15 PM.
